MICHELIN AND RALLY TURKEY



Michelin has scored four Rally Turkey wins with Citroën, including three in a row in 2003, 2004 and 2005

The last two Rally Turkeys produced one-two finishes for Toyota/Michelin in 2018 and Citroën/Michelin in 2019

Michelin tyres have won every one of the six Rally Turkeys they have contested as a WRC round

Michelin Group tyres also enjoyed success on cross-country rallying's Rally of the Orient in Turkey's Cappadocia region in the Noughties

RALLY TURKEY IS LIKELY TO BE ONE OF THE SEASON'S TOUGHEST TESTS OF THE CARS AND THEIR TYRES

After Rally Estonia's fast, smooth stages, we move on to Turkey which is likely to be one of the season's toughest tests of the cars and their tyres. We are expecting the usual hot weather in the country's Mugla region where the dirt tracks are pretty rough and strewn with stones. With

the first two visits to the event in its current form under their belts, the WRC teams and Michelin's technicians have a decent understanding of the wear-rates involved and how the stages cut up for the repeat passes. The hard-compound versions of the Michelin LTX Force and Michelin Latitude Cross face a stiff challenge and smart management of the available tyre allocations will be crucial from start to finish.

From 2003 until 2008, the Rally of Turkey was based in the Antalya/Kemer region in the Anatolian Mountains.

It moved closer to Istanbul in 2010

Sébastien Loeb holds the record for the highest number of Rally Turkey wins (3)

Marmaris is a seaside resort on the southwest Turkish coast, opposite the Greek island of Rhodes

Originally known as Physkos, Marmaris has previously been Greek, Roman, Byzantine and Ottoman
