-Dovizioso has finished fourth on four occasions in Misano, in 2009 and 2010 on a Honda, in 2012 on a Yamaha and 2014 on a Ducati before standing on the podium for the first time in 2017 in third place, also with Ducati.
-In 2018, he won the MotoGP® race at Misano after starting from fourth on the grid, which was the third successive win for a Ducati rider and the first time that has happened since 2008.
-In 2015 at Misano, he qualified and finished in eighth and in 2016 he both qualified and finished in sixth.
-Last year, he both qualified and finished the race in sixth place as the highest-placed Ducati rider.

5. Johann Zarco, Esponsorama Racing – Age: 30 – Nationality: French

-Zarco has competed at Misano for the last 11 years, with one win in Moto2™ in 2015 from pole position.
-He has finished on the podium at Misano a further two times: second in 2011 in 125cc and third in 2014 in Moto2™.
-He started from pole position in 2015 and 2016 in Moto2™.
-2017 was Zarco's first MotoGP® race at Misano; he finished 15th after running out of fuel on the last lap and pushing his bike to the finish line.
-In 2018, he started from ninth, dropped down to 13th and eventually finished the race in 10th.
-Last year, he qualified eighth but started 11th due to a 3-place grid penalty following an incident with Oliveira at the previous race in Silverstone. He dropped down to 17th on the opening lap but eventually finished in 11th.

9. Danilo Petrucci, Ducati Team – Age: 29 – Nationality: Italian

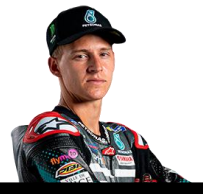
-Petrucci finished second in the FIM Superstock 1000 Cup race at Misano in 2011 and won the Superstock 600 European Championship race at the circuit in 2009.
-In 2012, his rookie season in MotoGP®, he finished 14th and in 2013 he was 15th.
-In 2014, he crashed on the second lap and in 2015, he was the first Ducati for the second race in a row, in sixth.
-In 2016, he qualified 15th and finished the race in 11th place.
-In 2017, Petrucci led the race from the seventh until the final lap. He was beaten by Marquez before the chequered flag but equalled his best result in MotoGP® at that time.
-In 2018, he qualified in eighth, struggled with his rear tyre and crossed the line 11th place.
-Last year, he qualified in 17th, which was his worst qualifying result since he was 18th in Argentina the year before. He worked his way through the field in the race to finish in 10th.

12. Maverick Viñales, Monster Energy Yamaha MotoGP – Age: 25 – Nationality: Spanish

-Viñales has had two podiums at Misano: second in Moto3™ in 2013 and third last year after qualifying on pole.
-In 2014, he finished fourth in Moto2™ and in 2015, he qualified in 14th position and finished the race in 14th place, his equal worst finishing position of his rookie season in MotoGP®.
-In 2016, he qualified on the front row in third place and finished the race in fifth after being given a one-place penalty mid-race for exceeding track limits.
-In 2017, he qualified on pole for the fourth time that season and finished fourth as the highest-placed Yamaha.
-In 2018, he started from the front row for the third time that season and finished the race in fifth place as the highest-placed Yamaha rider once again.
-Last year, he qualified on pole position which was Yamaha's sixth pole position since Misano returned to the Grand Prix calendar in 2007; he went on to finish the race in third behind Quartararo.

20. Fabio Quartararo, Petronas Yamaha SRT – Age: 21 – Nationality: French

-In 2015, Quartararo crashed at Turn 14 in Moto3™ FP2 at Misano, breaking his right ankle and forced to miss the race.
-In 2016, he both qualified and finished the Moto3™ race in 18th place.
-In 2017, he crossed the line in sixth place in the Moto2™ race, which was his best result at that time in the class.

35. Cal Crutchlow, LCR Honda Castrol – Age: 34 – Nationality: British

- Crutchlow won the WorldSSP race at Misano in 2009 and finished fourth in a WorldSBK race at the circuit in 2010.
- His best MotoGP[™] result at the track is third in 2018 after qualifying in sixth place.
- Before that, his best result was sixth in 2013 after he had to go through Q1 but took fifth place on the grid.
- In 2014 on the Ducati, Crutchlow finished ninth from 13th on the grid and in 2015, he qualified and finished in 11th.
- In 2016, he qualified in seventh and finished the race eighth as top Independent Team rider.
- In 2017, he qualified in fourth place as the top Independent Team rider and crashed on Lap 7 but rejoined the race to cross the line 13th.

- Smith finished on the podium twice at Misano in 125cc: second in 2008 and third in 2009 and he also started from pole in both 2009 and 2010.
- In 2013, his rookie year in the MotoGP[™] class, he finished the MotoGP[™] race in 11th position from 13th place on the grid and in 2014, he finished 7th at the San Marino Grand Prix.
- In 2015, he had a career-best MotoGP[™] result in second, and was the only rider to not change bikes.
- Smith was unable to race at Misano in 2016 as he was still recovering from a knee operation.

- Rins has raced at Misano for the last eight years, taking three podiums including two victories: a win in 2013 and again in 2014, both in Moto3[™], and a second place in 2016 in Moto2[™].
- He has qualified on the front row on three occasions at Misano, but not taken pole.
- In 2016, he qualified in eighth and finished the race in second place in Moto2[™].
- 2017 was Rins' first year riding a MotoGP[™] bike at Misano; he qualified in 20th on the grid but worked his way through the field to finish eighth, his best result at that time in MotoGP[™].
- In 2018, he qualified tenth, made a great start to take sixth on the opening lap, and finished in fourth place.

43. Jack Miller, Pramac Racing – Age: 25 – Nationality: Australian

- Miller qualified on pole and finished third in the Moto3[™] race at Misano in 2014.
- In 2015, he finished 12th in MotoGP[™] after losing places towards the end when his bike suffered electrical problems.
- He qualified in 17th in 2016 but had to withdraw on Sunday morning and did not start the race after having problems with the hand he injured at the Austrian GP.
- In 2017, Miller was 14th on grid and finished the race in sixth place.
- In 2018, he qualified in second place and with Lorenzo on pole position, this was the fifth Ducati 1–2 in the MotoGP[™] class and the first in back-to-back Grand Prix events. He crashed on Lap 3 at Turn 14 while sitting in fourth place.

44. Pol Espargaro, Red Bull KTM Factory Racing – Age: 29 – Nationality: Spanish

- Pol Espargaro finished second in the Moto2[™] race in 2012, his first podium finish at Misano.
- In 2013, he set a new Moto2[™] lap record on his way to winning the race from pole position.
- In 2014, his rookie season in MotoGP[™], he finished sixth and one place ahead of teammate Smith.
- In 2015, he retired on the penultimate lap of the race due to technical issues.
- In 2016 he qualified 10th and finished the race in ninth after challenging Crutchlow for eighth in the latter stages.
- In 2017, he qualified in 17th, but eventually managed to finish 11th despite dropping to 20th on the opening lap.
- In 2018, he qualified 20th but had to retire on Lap 18 after suffering with his collarbone broken at the Czech GP.

- Rossi has had six podium finishes from 12 MotoGP® races at Misano, including race wins in 2008, 2009 and 2014, with 2009 being his only pole position start at the circuit.
- Rossi finished second in 2012 riding a Ducati, his only dry weather podium of the year.
- He won at Misano in 2014, it was the first of two victories he took that year.
- In 2015, he ended his run of 16 podium finishes when he finished fifth after being one of the last riders to change back to slicks.
- In 2016, he qualified second and finished second after leading across the line from Lap 2 to Lap 21.
- In 2017, he missed the San Marino GP after breaking his right tibia and fibula following an enduro training accident.
- In 2018, he both qualified and finished in seventh place at his home GP.
- Last year, he qualified seventh after struggling in Q2. He eventually finished the race as the third Yamaha rider behind teammate Viñales.

- Oliveira has had two podium finishes at Misano, finishing second in the Moto3™ race in 2015 and second in Moto2™ in 2018.
- In 2019, Oliveira raced at the San Marino GP for the first time on a MotoGP® bike; he qualified in 19th place. He crashed at Turn 4 while sitting in 15th but remounted to finish in 16th despite dropping down to 21st.

6. Stefan Bradl, Repsol Honda Team – Age: 30 – Nationality: German

- Bradl has had one podium finish at Misano, second to M. Marquez in Moto2™ in 2011, after qualifying on pole.
- He battled for a podium up to lap 18 in the MotoGP® race in 2012, but lost out in the closing stages to finish sixth.
- In 2013, Bradl started from seventh and finished fifth after passing Crutchlow on the final lap, which is his best result so far in MotoGP at Misano.
- In 2014, he crashed out of the race on the seventh lap, and in 2015, he finished in 16th.
- In 2016 riding an Aprilia, he missed Q2 and qualified in 13th after using his second bike (his first bike had a problem in FP4). He finished the race in 12th.
- 2018 was his last appearance in MotoGP® in Misano to date, as a wildcard for Honda. He qualified in 18th but crashed out of the race while sitting in 17th.
